## TERMS and CONDITIONS

**Safe Boating Certificate:** Connecticut State Law mandates that anyone wishing to operate any motorized vessel or sailing vessel over 19 feet requires a Connecticut Safe Boating Certificate. Accordingly, please attach a copy of your safe boating certificate with your registration for the Power Boating or Keel Boat classes. (If you do not have a certificate, we can assist you in obtaining your certificate prior to start of your class.)

**NOTE:** Required for Basic, Intermediate and Advanced Keel boating & membership using boats over 19 feet or with a motor.

**Reservations & Check In:** Boats must be checked in and out. Please call 203-382-3661 in advance to reserve a boat. Last boat leaves the beach 2 hours prior to sunset. Reservations are required. CCB reserves the right to suspend sailing at any time without notice. A late charge of \$ 35.00/hr applies if you are back after sunset. (Not debatable or prorated per minute... 5 minutes late = \$35.00 !)

**Pass the Muster:** Members must be checked out prior to first sail. Members taking out boats over 24 feet must attend and complete the CCB Advanced Keel Boating Class or show completion of similar class & experience. There is a \$35.00 fee for all check out sails & associated pop quizzes... (i.e. know your navigation, rules & knots)

**Good Seamanship & Behavior:** Behavior (including but not limited to) hazardous operation, negligence or poor seamanship may result in the suspension or cancellation of membership at any time. Drinking is not allowed on boats CCB while underway.

**Towing & Running Aground:** It happens to everyone at least once ! **SOFT GROUNDINGS:** The first time we have to pull you off is \$ 35.00. After that we charge \$60.00 / hr (which is less than Sea Tow's \$ 100.00 plus / hr !) If you run aground and need assistance, call us on VHF Channel 71 or call us by cell phone at 203-382-3661

**HARD GROUNDINGS:** Hard groundings are on the rocks or on the beach. ...Towing is charged at \$ 120.00 / hr, plus you are responsible for damage incurred to the boat, rigging and hardware. (i.e. navigation is important & serious) Again, call us on VHF Channel 71 or call us by cell phone 203-382-3661.

If it's an emergency or you are in a life threatening situation... call MAYDAY on Ch. 16 and speak to the US Coast Guard (& still call the CCB office).

**Big Boat (Over 24 feet) Charges:** Larger boats cost CCB more to maintain and care for. To keep the boats shipshape, we must charge a maintenance & fuel fee of \$ 45.00/hr for 2-8 hr day sails or \$ 300.00/day for overnight or multi-night cruises.

**Navigation:** Our sailing center for small boats is in Bridgeport's Cedar Creek (near Nun # 12) in Black Rock Harbor, across from Black Rock. The larger boats are moored in Yellow Mill Channel in Bridgeport Harbor. You can find NOAA Chart 12369 online at [www.charts.noaa.gov/OnLineViewer/12369.shtml](http://www.charts.noaa.gov/OnLineViewer/12369.shtml) We encourage every skipper to study and memorize the sailing area, and to purchase and carry charts for the sailing area onboard with them at all times. Though electronic navigation is embraced, good old paper charts are the fallback when the batteries go dead, or electronics get wet, or lightning strikes.....

**Additional CCB Courses Offered:** CT Community Boating offers additional courses in conjunction with Safe Boating America such as the CT Safe Boating Certification (required for sail boats over 19 feet long and all power driven boats), Basic Navigation, Master's Certificate training and Celestial Navigation. Please ask us about the next scheduled course.
